Welcome to the Juneau Co-op Preschool Community! We hope this message finds you enjoying your summer. We're so excited to greet our returning students and families and meet our new ones.

Our Preschool is entering its 44th year with an incredible staff of compassionate and competent individuals. This year, our staff is all new and our classes options are a little different, but the Co-Op is the same welcoming, warm environment we have known and loved it to be. Our Program Practices and Philosophies remain the same, and we maintain our unique CoOperative style services with the highest quality care. Our Preschool Staff and Board prioritize meeting the needs of our community while providing enriching opportunities for learning, growing, and having a great time!

VOLUNTEER WORK DAY SCHEDULES

As a CoOperative, an important part of our model is to have parents help out in the classroom each day. Our Class Representative will be putting together a schedule of who volunteers on which day. We will schedule one work parent per preschool day. You can expect to have 8 to 10 work days over the course of the year, though you are always welcome to join on your own time too!

A work day is a day assigned to each family in which a parent, guardian, or close family friend attend the school from **8:30am** - **12:30pm**. This person also supplies snack for the class for the day. Family volunteers are crucial to creating a welcoming, well supported, and high quality program. Your child will also benefit knowing that their family is a valued piece of their learning environment! You will receive more details about what is entailed in an actual preschool work day during your orientation visit, as well as in the Parent Handbook.

*Please send our Class Representative, Brenna Reeder, input about when you are and are not available (e.g., only Mondays, no Mondays, when you'll be out of town on vacation, etc) to be scheduled for workdays. While best attempts are made to accommodate requests, it is not always possible to meet all requests when coordinating thirty families. Your understanding is appreciated.

IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

Returning preschoolers: Preschooler immunization records are kept on file and you do not need to provide an updated copy unless your child received or needs additional shots this year.

New preschoolers: Provide a copy of your child's immunization record which: (1) lists dates and dose numbers for each vaccine and (2) is certified by a medical provider.

New and returning families requesting exemptions for medical or religious reasons must submit current forms with required doctor signature (medical) or notarization (religious) *each year*.

**Licensing regulations require that we have a current immunization record or a notarized waiver for all children prior to preschool attendance.

FAMILY JOBS

Our preschool is a cooperative endeavor, run by parents and teachers working together to provide a rich, stimulating, loving environment for our students. Each family will have a role in assisting to run the school. Most returning families already have a job and may continue with it unless they'd like to discuss a change. FIRST DAYS OF PRESCHOOL

Thursday, Aug 22 OR Fri, Aug 23

The transition to preschool is easier for new children if just half the class attends on the first days of preschool. This means that your preschooler will only attend one morning during this first week. If your child is enrolled part time, their first day will be dependent on their Program (2 Day Program will attend on Thursday, 3 Day Program will attend on Friday, Children enrolled in our Full Week Morning and Preschool Plus Program may choose their first day.)
